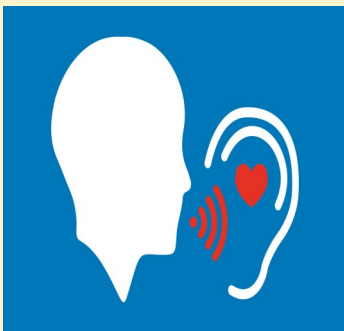


Don't forget "We Spring the Clocks" forward by an hour, next Sunday March 8th, as Daylight Savings time begins at 2:00am.

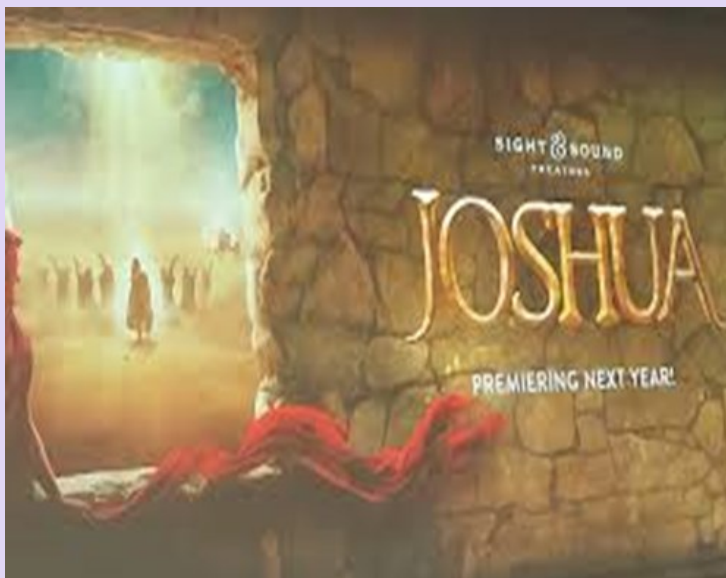
