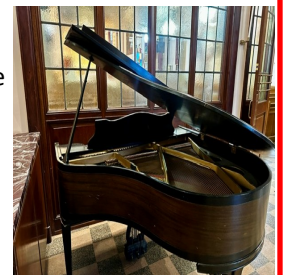

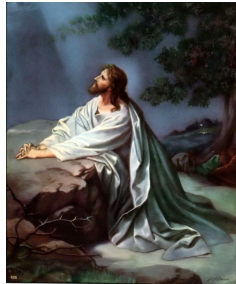
OLMC Memorial Candles
