With heavy yet grateful hearts, we share that Fr. Wilfred has been reassigned to St. Gerard in Yorkton.

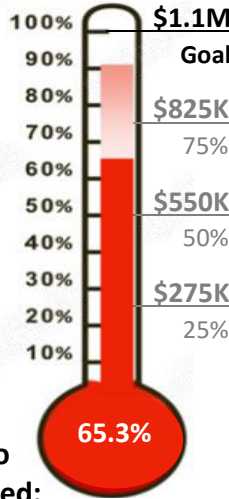
On August 1st, we will warmly welcome Fr. James Owolagba to Holy Family Parish. Please keep both priests and our parish in your prayers during this time of transition.

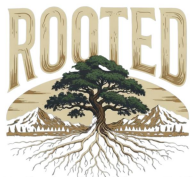
THE MOST PRECIOUS GIFT

ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA

Patron Saint of lost belongings, lost people, fishermen, the poor & oppressed, and travelers

Feast Day falls on June 13.

St. Anthony was born in 1195 in Lisbon, Portugal. At 15, he joined the religious order of St. Augustine; he studied intensely, learning Augustinian theology that he would later combine with the Franciscan vision. He joined the Franciscans and was sent to preach and to teach his fellow friars throughout northern Italy, first in Bologna and then in Padua. His reputation drew large crowds, and the power of his words converted them. He became ill and died at the age of 36; he was canonized within the year.

The reason for invoking St. Anthony's help in finding lost or stolen things is traced back to an incident in his own life. A novice who had grown tired of religious life stole Anthony's treasured book of psalms. Anthony prayed for book's return; the thieving novice was moved to return the book and return to the Order.

St. Anthony of Padua's life is what every Christian's life is meant to be; a steady courage, the call to love & forgive, to be concerned for the needs of others, to deal with crisis great & small, and to have our feet solidly on the ground of total trusting love & dependence on God.

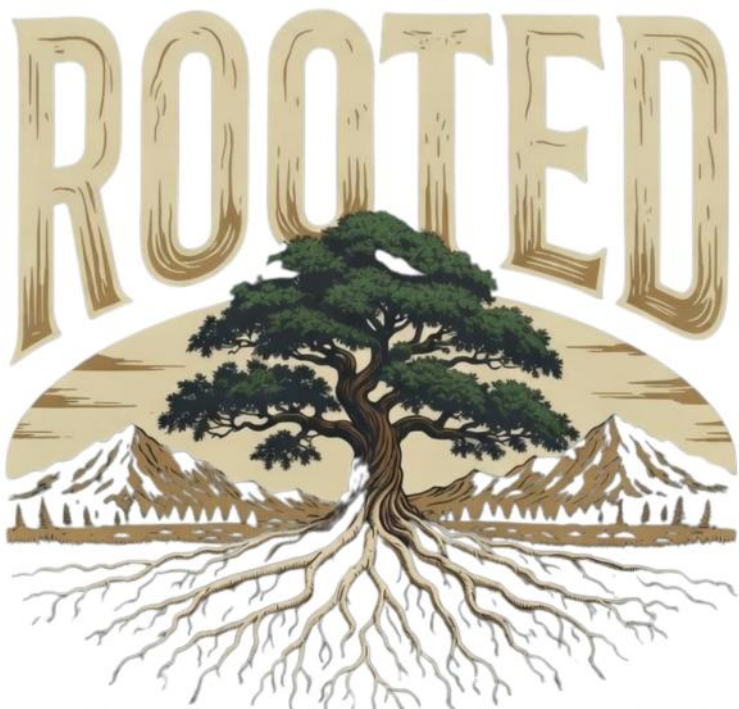

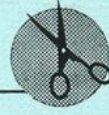

Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter: Magnifica Humanitas

Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter, Magnifica Humanitas, was released today. It focuses on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. The letter is dated 15 May, to commemorate the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's Encyclical Letter, Rerum Novarum. The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development offers the following synopsis of the Encyclical Letter: "Magnifica Humanitas offers insights into the protection of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence, recognizing a profound epochal shift. It places the dignity of the human person at the centre as the criteria for guiding technical progress. The Church's social teaching accompanies these transformations, pointing to the common good, solidarity and subsidiarity as the fundamental benchmarks for understanding and interpreting the transformation currently underway. It proposes, as an alternative to the culture of power and war, a civilization of love founded on justice, dialogue and shared responsibility."

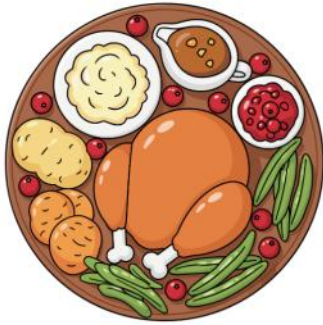

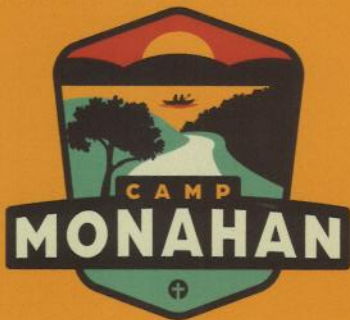
St. Raphael School
