Pastor's Corner

Phishing Scams

It's come to my attention that some of you have received fake emails CLAIMING to be me, asking for money or favours. Rest assured that I have never sent anyone an email or message of this sort. If you find that an email claiming to be from me doesn't seem like me, verify by emailing the office with the message or contact me directly. You'll also notice that the email address is different than my office or personal email. Phishing is a cybercrime where attackers trick people into giving sensitive information through fake emails, texts, or calls.

- Criminals pose as trusted sources (such as parishes and other businesses) and create urgent messages to push victims into clicking links or sharing credentials.
- Phishing uses spoofed senders, scary messages, and fake websites that look real to steal login details or financial data.
- Warning signs include too good to be true offers, unexpected attachments, urgent language, unusual senders, and suspicious URLs.
- Anyone can be targeted, so protection includes avoiding unknown links, using MFA, verifying senders, and relying on security software.

Tips to Protect yourself from phishing attacks

1. Don't open e-mails from senders you are not familiar with.
2. Don't ever click on a link inside of an e-mail unless you know exactly where it is going.
3. If you are asked to provide sensitive information, check that the URL of the page starts with "HTTPS" instead of just "HTTP." The "S" stands for "secure." It's not a guarantee that a site is legitimate, but most legitimate sites use HTTPS because it's more secure. HTTP sites, even legitimate ones, are vulnerable to hackers.
4. Enable Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA): Utilize MFA wherever possible to add an extra layer of security. Even if phishers obtain your password, they'll need to bypass additional verification steps to access your account.
5. Lookout for the digital certificate of a website.
6. To layer that protection, if you get an e-mail from a source, you are unsure of, navigate to the provided link manually by entering the legitimate website address into your browser.
7. Mouseover the link to see if it's a legitimate link.
8. If you suspect an e-mail isn't legitimate, take a name or some text from the message and put it into a search engine to see if any known phishing attacks exist using the same methods.

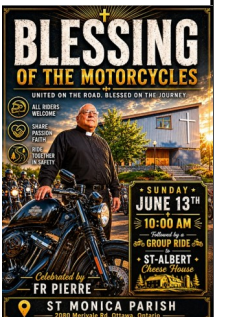
Four Seasons Book Club



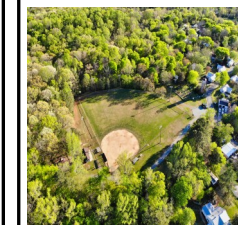
