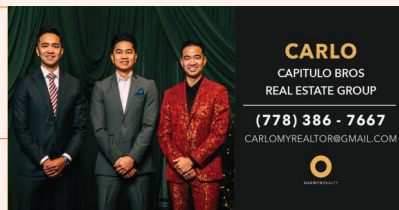

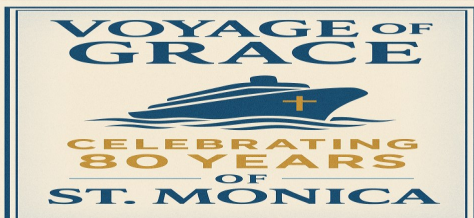

### SUPPORT OUR PROJECT ADVANCE PARISH PROJECTS FOR 2026

1. Landscaping the grotto area & the backyard of the rectory.
2. Upgrading of the parish security system.
3. Line painting of the parking lot.
4. Carpet cleaning in the church.
5. For the church hall: A large format **100"** display wired into the existing video distribution systems so that it can display either text or moving pictures. This is to be placed on the back wall of the hall between the two acoustical tiles.
6. For the sanctuary: Two 100 inch displays mounted either side of the altar using the current short throw projection technique onto screens that will reflect the maximum ambient light back into the congregation for the text of the hymns being sung. While these will do video content the main application is considered to be text to the hymns.
7. For the main sanctuary & the entrance way to the church: Updating the lighting system for both the narthex (or the foyer) & improving the lighting coverage in the nave of the church, which will require considerable labour to move the existing pews. This is a substantial piece of work requiring a lift that is capable of reaching over 30 feet as the working height and considerable application in regards to the existing lights. Overall, this will improve the performance of the lighting as well as updating it.
8. Purchase of LED poster panel.

### 12 Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

7. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart is exposed and honored.
10. I will give priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be erased.
12. I promise you, in the excessive mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in My displeasure nor without receiving the sacraments. My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in that last moment.
