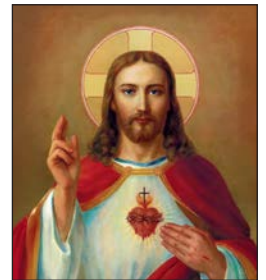
SOLEMNITY of MOST SACRED HEART of JESUS



Friday, June 12, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus—and World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests.

"The term 'Sacred Heart of Jesus' denotes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of his being, and his person... Devotion to the Sacred Heart...calls for a fundamental attitude of conversion and reparation, of love and gratitude, apostolic commitment and dedication to Christ and his saving work." Exciting News! Our growing project for 2026 has begun. Though we gave up the Murphy piece (NE of the city), we continue to manage the 90 acres of land straight north of the church. Once again we have two projects underway—the "Farm Growing" project seeded to alfalfa and wheat, and the "Potato Patch" project.

There are a lot of expenses to growing a crop, so why not become a *Fundraising Farmer*? Donations are welcome, for which you will receive a tax receipt and a free harvest supper in the fall. Since this initiative began in 2011, over \$400,000 has gone to our Building Fund, plus over \$60,000 to the Canadian Food Grains Bank.
