With heavy yet grateful hearts, we share that Fr. Wilfred has been reassigned to St. Gerard in Yorkton.

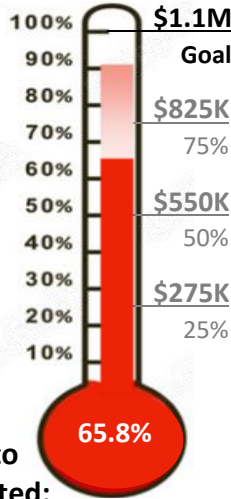
On August 1st, we will warmly welcome Fr. James Owolagba to Holy Family Parish. Please keep both priests and our parish in your prayers during this time of transition.

### QUESTION:

What is the significance of making the sign of the cross before and after private prayer?

### ANSWER:

The sign of the cross is closely tied to baptism. Jesus told the apostles, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Mt 28:19).

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us that when Catholics are baptized "the sign of the cross, on the threshold of the celebration, marks with the imprint of Christ the one who is going to belong to him and signifies the grace of the Redemption Christ won for us by his cross" (CCC 1235).

Thereafter, each time we make the sign of the cross we remember that we belong to Christ.

The Christian begins his day, his prayers, and his activities with the sign of the cross: "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." The baptized person dedicates the day to the glory of God and calls on the Savior's grace which lets him act in the Spirit as a child of the Father. ## Archbishop's Annual Appeal Spring Giving Campaign - Gospel Reflection

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus looks out at the crowds and is moved with compassion. He sees people who are "harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd." His response is not distant concern, but action. First, He calls His disciples. Then, He sends them. The calling of the Twelve Apostles reminds us that God's work in the world is carried out through ordinary people. They are not chosen because they are perfect or fully prepared, but because they are willing to follow. Jesus then entrusts them with His mission: to proclaim the Good News, to heal, to bring hope, and to serve. "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." These words still speak to us today. The need is great and the call continues.

### Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter: Magnifica Humanitas

Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter, Magnifica Humanitas, was released today. It focuses on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. The letter is dated 15 May, to commemorate the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's Encyclical Letter, Rerum Novarum. The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development offers the following synopsis of the Encyclical Letter: "Magnifica Humanitas offers insights into the protection of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence, recognizing a profound epochal shift. It places the dignity of the human person at the centre as the criteria for guiding technical progress. The Church's social teaching accompanies these transformations, pointing to the common good, solidarity and subsidiarity as the fundamental benchmarks for understanding and interpreting the transformation currently underway. It proposes, as an alternative to the culture of power and war, a civilization of love founded on justice, dialogue and shared responsibility."
