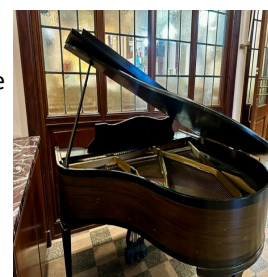
Bereavement Ministry
