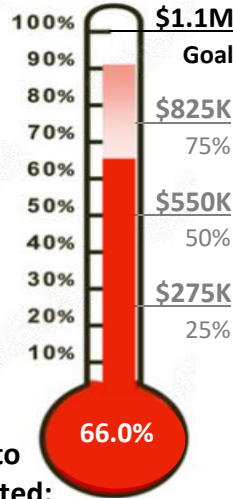

### QUESTION:

I am terrified of the suffering I will need to endure in purgatory. What are the most effective things I can do with what time I've got left on earth?

### ANSWER:

First off, we should be terrified of hell, given its eternal punishments, not Purgatory, whose sufferings are not everlasting.

That said, we shouldn't take Purgatory or its sufferings lightly. In that regard, the best thing you can do is to strive to grow in holiness, asking our Lord Jesus Christ to help you become more like him each and every day.

In the process, you'll become less attached to unhealthy attachments and thus prepare yourself better for heaven. And when you fail, seek God's absolution in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and begin anew.

Finally, you can seek a partial or plenary indulgence for yourself, and also for departed loved ones and other souls in Purgatory who—God knows, so trust in him—are most in need of his mercy. ## Archbishop's Annual Appeal Spring Giving Campaign - Gospel Reflection

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus Christ speaks words of encouragement to His disciples: "Do not be afraid." He acknowledges that following Him will not always be easy. There will be fear, misunderstanding, and even opposition. Yet His message is consistent and strong. Fear does not have the final word. God does. Jesus reminds His disciples that what is hidden will be revealed, and what is spoken in darkness will come to light. Nothing is outside of God's care or knowledge. Even in moments of uncertainty, we are held by a God who sees and knows us completely. Three times in this passage, Jesus tells His followers not to be afraid. He calls them to trust, even when the cost of discipleship feels heavy. The One who watches over even the smallest sparrow also watches over each of us with deep care. At the heart of this Gospel is a simple invitation: to choose faith over fear.

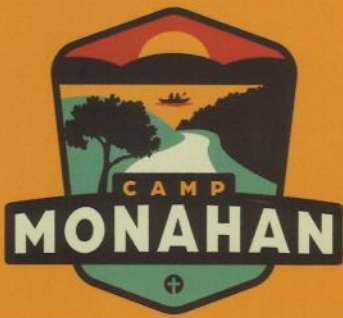

## Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter: Magnifica Humanitas

Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter, Magnifica Humanitas, was released today. It focuses on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. The letter is dated 15 May, to commemorate the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's Encyclical Letter, Rerum Novarum. The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development offers the following synopsis of the Encyclical Letter: "Magnifica Humanitas offers insights into the protection of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence, recognizing a profound epochal shift. It places the dignity of the human person at the centre as the criteria for guiding technical progress. The Church's social teaching accompanies these transformations, pointing to the common good, solidarity and subsidiarity as the fundamental benchmarks for understanding and interpreting the transformation currently underway. It proposes, as an alternative to the culture of power and war, a civilization of love founded on justice, dialogue and shared responsibility."

## THE GREATNESS OF THE HUMAN PERSON IN THE FACE OF THE PROMISES OF AI

### The risk of the technocratic paradigm

- Efficiency —→ ⚠ becomes the sole criterion
- Profit —→ ⚠ guides decisions
- AI —→ ⚠ accelerates the problem
- Person —→ ⚠ reduced to performance

### Artificial Intelligence

#### What it does

- Processes data
- Recognises patterns
- Is fast and powerful

#### What it does NOT do

- ⚠ Has no consciousness
- ⚠ Does not love, does not suffer
- ⚠ Is not responsible

### Simulates intelligence, but is not human

#### Risks of AI

- Speed** — less critical thinking
- False objectivity** — hides bias
- Simulated relationships** — illusion
- Concentrated power** — everything in the hands of a few

#### Criteria for a more humane AI

- Human dignity
- The common good
- Social justice
- Reliability
- Transparency

**IA is not neutral, it reflects values and choices**

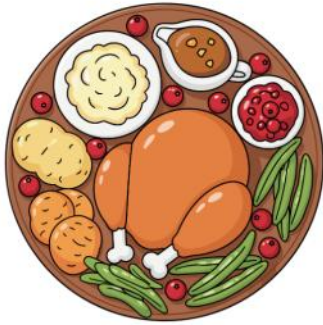

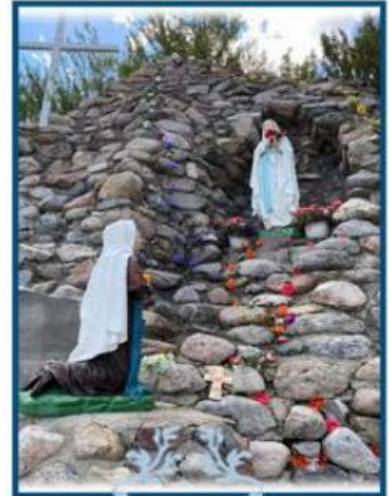

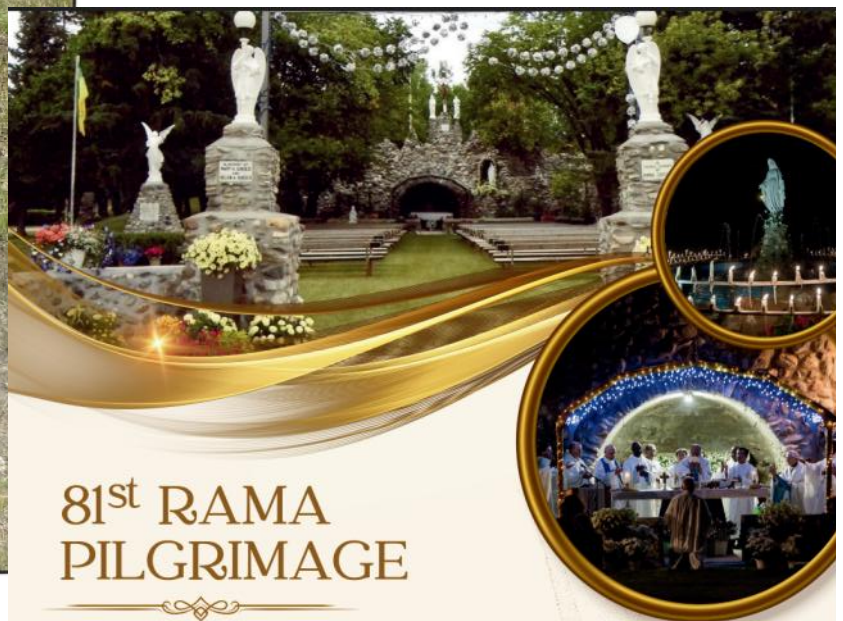
