Pastor's Corner

Protecting your Wealth and Reducing Taxes seminar

In last weeks' bulletin, you may have noticed a blurb about an upcoming seminar at the parish on July 14 at 7:00pm. Let me provide you with some context for this seminar. Last Summer, the Archdiocese purchased a 9-acre piece of land, at 828 River Rd., that is intended for the future construction of a new Catholic church building. As the Catholic population grows exponentially in the regions of Nepean, Barrhaven and Ottawa south, the Archdiocese needs a 1000 seat capacity church in addition to the current parishes in our area.

The purpose of the **Protecting your Wealth and Reducing Taxes seminar** 'is to help you as parishioners, understand how your taxes are currently being used and how you can lower your taxes significantly so that you will have more money to donate to the charities of your choice (such as the construction of a new church, or by leaving more money for the future of your children).

I am pleased to introduce Joanne Kudakiewicz as the facilitator of this seminar. She is a major fundraiser for the Elizabeth Bruyere Hospital, The Shepherds of Good Hope, The Ottawa Cancer Foundation, and many other charities in the region. She has also been a guest on various television and radio stations.

The bottom line? Parish dinners are wonderful for building up our community, but they won't provide us with the kind of funds needed to build a future large capacity church. Joanne is a member of the new church building committee. Her experience shows in her understanding of parishes, taxes, and our desire to support charitable giving for capital projects, while retaining as much money in our pockets as possible. Please join me at this seminar.

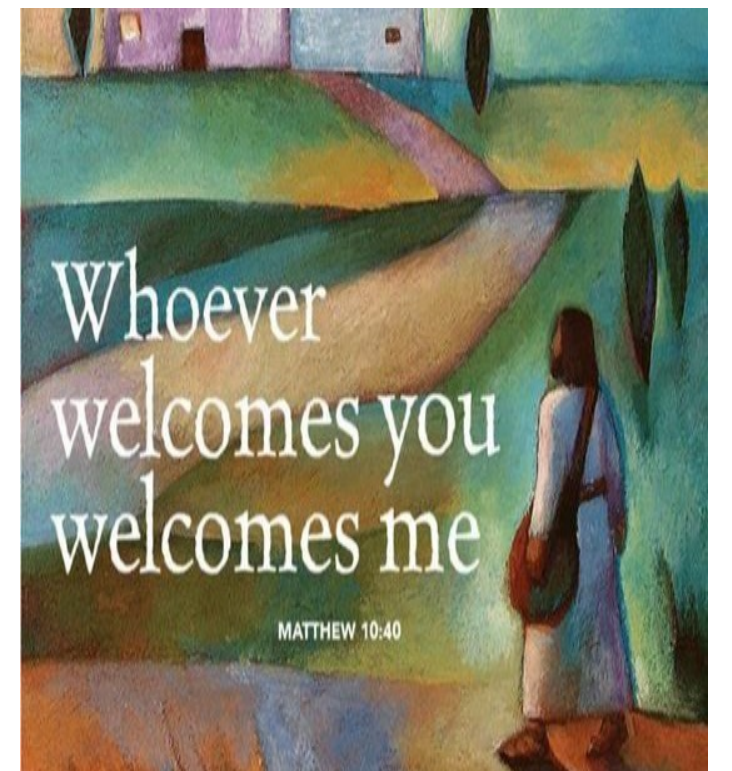
Beginning July 2nd, the office will be open Monday to Thursday 9 am to 3:30 pm , and Friday 9 am to noon.
