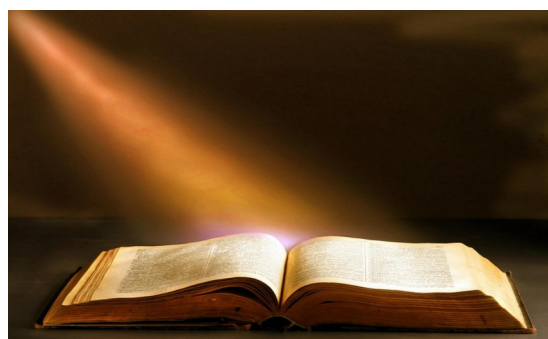

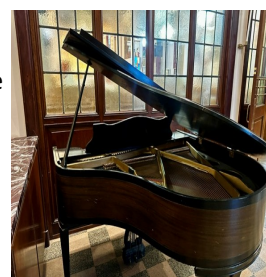
Bereavement Ministry
