Pass the Ball

As many know already, I will be taking on a new pastoral appointment within the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall. As of June 1st, I've been named the Associate Director of Vocations for the archdiocese to aid Fr. Connor O'Hara with the francophone discerners to priesthood and seminarians. As of August 1st, I will be the associate pastor at St. Philip's in Richmond, St. Clare's Mission in Dwyer Hill, and Holy Redeemer in Kanata. I want to thank all of you for your prayers, best wishes, and words of encouragement as I leave St Andrew and St Monica. Over the next few weeks, I will be taking some vacation time, as well as a church management course at Villanova University in Philadelphia over the month of July. Hence, my last Sunday Masses with you will be July 4th and 5th. Since many have asked, my last official day here in Nepean-Barrhaven is July 31st, the feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola. It is quite fitting that this day will be "moving day," given that St. Ignatius is the founder of the Society of Jesus, the Jesuits, who have been known over the centuries for their missionary zeal. The best examples are the Canadian Jesuit Martyrs, St. Jean de Brébeuf and his companions. I invite you to keep all priests moving at this time in your prayers.

St. Ignatius used to say that every Jesuit should always have "one foot raised." This is the symbol of their disposition and readiness for the mission. To always have one foot raised, means to be ready for service, or ready to be sent out, wherever the Spirit leads us. And so I enter into this new mission with "one foot raised." Speaking of a raised foot, most of us have witnessed or at least heard of much discussion about FIFA World Cup. Canada, along with the United States and Mexico are host nations. In North America, we use the word soccer, but much of the world refers to this sport as football. As of the writing of the article, Canada just secured a place in the round of 16 after their victory against South Africa during injury time at the very end of their match! Pope Leo XIV in his comments during his Apostolic Journey to Spain before the start of the FIFA tournament made a beautiful reflection that I share here: "Whoever doesn't know how to pass the ball, even if they have talent, still hasn't understood the game." In life, we need to learn how to pass the ball. In the next few weeks, I will be passing the ball to Fr. Primus Chika. I was able to bring him to some of our elementary schools and high schools a few weeks ago and he is eager to continue this work. But the important thing to remember is that he has gifts that I do not have. Each and every one of us has gifts that others do not have. But when we are on the same team, when we learn to pass the ball, that is how we secure a victory.

Let's always remember the name of the game is winning souls for Christ. The goal is to help each other get to heaven. It is to help seek out, find, and bring back those who have gone "out of bounds" so-to-speak. We thank God for the gift of the priests who provide for us the sacraments, the nutrition, we need to score that goal. Let's keep working together, with one foot raised to pass the ball to each other, by bringing forward our gifts for the mission Christ as entrusted to all of us. St Andrew and St Monica, pray for us.
