Servant of God, Fr John Hardon:

Devotion to the Precious Blood is not a spiritual option, it is a spiritual obligation, and that not only for priests, but for every follower of Christ. I really believe that one of the symptoms of modern society (and I would even include, sadly, modern Catholic society)—one of the symptoms of a growing, gnawing secularism is the lessening and the weakening of devotion to the Precious Blood.

Devotion, as we know, is a composite of three elements: It is first, **veneration**; it is secondly, **invocation**; and it is thirdly, **imitation**. In other words, devotion to the Precious Blood of Christ, the Lamb of God who was slain, is first of all to be veneration on our part, which is a composite of knowledge, love and adoration. We are to study to come to a deeper understanding of what those two casual words, *Precious Blood*, really mean.



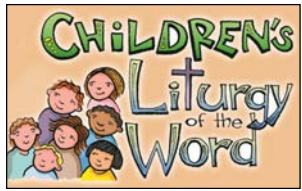

Catholic Christian Outreach is offering a free, 60-minute

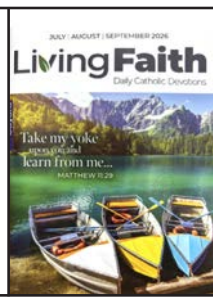
webinar to introduce participants to the principles of **Intentional Accompaniment**, a practice that has had a positive impact in numerous dioceses and parishes.
