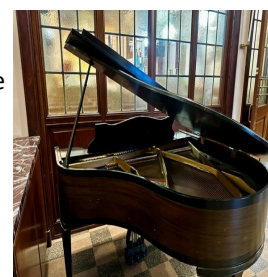
Bereavement Ministry
