Associate Pastor's Corner 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Imagine if God were to appear to you in a dream and say to you what He said to King Solomon in today's first reading: "Solomon, you have served Me well. Ask of Me anything, and I will give it to you." What would you ask for? Many people would ask God for worldly things: a stable income, a comfortable career, a life of going from one pleasure to the next. Ultimately, many of us would ask for an earthly paradise here in this world. Others may be less selfish and may ask for things that are more noble: good health, a loving family, friends and colleagues who are faithful and who make living a real joy. But King Solomon asked for none of these things. His reply to God was, "Grant me wisdom, that I may govern your people well, discerning good from evil." Solomon asked for a wise heart, one that gives glory to God. And God was pleased with him.

St. Thomas Aquinas, one of the Church's greatest Doctors, was on his deathbed when Jesus appeared before him and asked a similar question. Our Lord said to him, "Thomas, you have written well of Me. Ask Me what you would like as your reward." Saint Thomas was not just a great intellectual with an astute mind; he was also a man whose heart was fully in God and for God. So when asked what he would like as his reward, the Saint simply replied with four short words in Latin: *Nihil nisi Te, Domine*: "Nothing but Thee, O Lord."

God is our ultimate reward. When we have Him, we have everything. The Saints understood this truth so well. They asked for God as their reward, and not the things that God gives, wonderful though they might be. Let us examine our own heart and meditate on this great question. If God promised to give you anything you wanted, what would you ask Him for? The Scriptures tell us that where our treasure is, there too will be our heart. If our treasure is in God, then we will never be content with anything less than God.
