Putting our trust in God, in everything we do, in good times and in bad, means that God's plan for our lives may be quite different than what we planned. When one door closes, another one opens. Trust in God; His plan is always better.

THE PROCESS OF BECOMING CATHOLIC



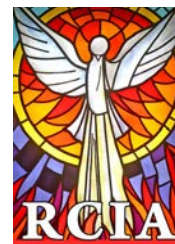
If you (or someone you know) would like to hear more about Jesus, and are willing to place your trust in God, we invite you to an OCIA Inquiry Session.

Inquiry Sessions **do not** assume a commitment to become Catholic, but are for those who wish to inquire, explore, and grow in their relationship with God. Perhaps you've never been baptized into any faith, or you've been baptized into a non-Catholic faith. Or you may be a baptized Catholic who would like to receive the sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation. All are invited to attend Inquiry Sessions until they decide to join the Catholic Faith Family.

They are then invited to enter the process called the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). This process will lead to their reception of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism (for those who have not been baptized), Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Some people will need more time than others as they prepare for this lifetime commitment to the Catholic Church. The usual length of preparation time is 1-2 years. However, it may be shorter for those who have already been baptized and are seeking full communion in the Catholic Church (receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist).

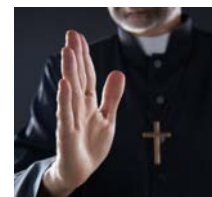
For respect for human life...

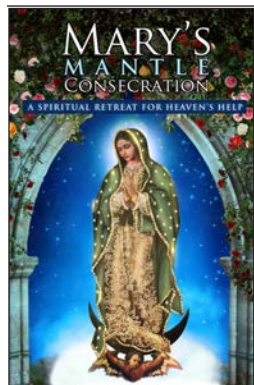


God's unwavering love is the ultimate answer to the isolation and neglect so often experienced by the elderly. It brings comfort and hope, assuring us that the Lord knows each of us
